IOUO, our dear Father in heaven, the Dear God, sometimes is simply called "God". Translated, his name IOUO means "He is". Does your name also have a meaning?

However, some simply call God "the Dear God", because God consists only of love.

Your daddy got you as his child. Either you were his first child or a further one. The first child is called Firstborn and can be a he or a she.

IOUO God had a son as his first child, too. Then he still got many other children in heaven and later on earth. The Son of God, who was the firstborn of the Father IOUO is called Jesus. He was the first angel. Angels are persons in heaven, who, like God, cannot be seen by humans. Jesus was the archangel of God and was called Michael in the beginning. Archangel means "first of angels".

Today, by becoming children of mom and dad, we always get grandmas and grandpas, the parents of daddy and mommy.

But Jesus did not get that; no grandma, no grandpa. He did not even have a mom, but only had his father, the Dear God, whose name is "IOUO". This name is very important to him. Everybody should know it and like to hear it. Do you like to hear your name, too? Can you already write or spell it?

Also, Jesus had neither uncles nor aunts, neither brothers nor sisters, nor any cousin. Do you have grandpas and grandmas, uncles and aunts, brothers or sisters or cousins, my dear reader, our dear reading child?

Why did Jesus not even have a mom but only a father, the Dear God, whose name is IOUO? Jesus could not have a mom, because at that time no mom had been created yet by God.


Jesus should be a substitute for a mom for all those angels, who were created after him. These again became brothers of Jesus, but thus also had something like a mom.

The Bible is the book given to us by God. In it, it says that everything after Jesus' own creation was created by means of Jesus. Your father can only have children because your mother is there. It was similar with God at that time. Everything created by louo was created with the help of Jesus. Jesus was the beginning of God's creation and then God's tool for creating everything else. He is therefore called "the master workman" of God.

louo God also wished that Jesus could become the start of all things. God himself, however, did not have any beginning. He was already there in all times of the past. It is said, that "he is from eternity". But Jesus should be the start of everything else. He should become such one. Similarly, your dear daddy wants to give way to your dear mom in all things, because he loves her so much. Nevertheless, he remains the head of the family.

Your daddy loves your mom like himself. Your dear mom loves your dad like herself, too.

louo, loved Jesus so very much, too. Of course, Jesus was no woman or even a wife for God. But he was his son, whom he taught everything by himself. Does your mom and your dad also teach you many things by themselves? Do they not show you so many things of life, too? Things, that are totally new to you? Jesus was always joyful around louo, his father. He was happy about louo's work, like the humans when they were created later on. Are you also joyful and happy when being around your parents, your daddy and your mom, who love you so much?

When you build a house, the first stone is called "foundation stone". In the old times, it was always laid at a corner of the house. Therefore, it was also called "corner stone". Likewise, Jesus is sometimes called the "corner stone" of the whole creation, because he was the first piece and the fundamental start of everything God created in his great love.

Before that, God was always alone – for an unimaginably long time. He could think of anything, could speak to himself and imagine all the things that did not yet exist. He could plan them or discard them again. Beyond that, he could do many other things which can be done by oneself. But then at one time, louo didn't want to be alone anymore. Being alone didn't seem good to him any longer. He didn't want to think for himself only, and wanted to love someone and have someone around to show his full love to someone who would be glad and thankful by starting to love as well.

Thus, louo also wanted to experience the joy and comfort that you feel when being loved. Therefore, he first created Jesus, whose name was first "Michael". "Michael" means "Who is like God?". He wasn't called "Jesus" until much later, when salvation was at stake. "Jesus" means "louo is salvation".


When louo created Jesus, he became daddy and mommy for him at the same time.

There are also families today, where the daddy is bringing up his child alone and must also be the mom. Sometimes, however, a mom must also be the daddy. Do you know such families? How is it in your case?

God is always called "Father" in the Bible, which is the book where God had all these things written down.

Nevertheless, God was always a little bit a mom or a mother. Therefore, God created every human and also every animal with a little bit of both sexes. A male animal or a male human always has some minor things in him which are female. A female animal or a woman always has some minor things in her which are male. It is just the same with louo himself. Thus, Jesus had someone like a mom for himself, when he was an angel in heaven.

But much later, Iouo God sent his son Jesus from heaven down to the earth, where God had created the humans with Jesus as a helper. There on earth, Jesus became a human just like you and I.



First, he was a baby, then a little boy. Then he went to school and learned a trade from his father and then he became a man.

Therefore, he then got a second father who was a human called Joseph. Joseph's ancestor was the famous David. God himself could not become a human father for Jesus here on earth. It is not possible for him to become human. louo is an unlimited God and too great for this purpose. For Jesus to become a real human he got a real mom. That was a situation he had never experienced before. This real mom carried Jesus in her belly until his birth when he was a fully-grown baby. Thus, this mom was really pregnant with Jesus. The one who fathered Jesus was not Joseph but God himself with his "Holy Spirit". That is his power which is also called "the finger of God". Therefore, God's hand was the source.

The mom was a very dear and simple woman called "Mary". "Mary" means "Beloved One". Jesus finally got a dear mom and now really knew how it feels to have a real mom. My dear child, be glad and thankful for having a mom!

Do you have a mom? Then you can be thankful for that and you can thank God for it. This is called "a prayer to God". It is simply talking to God Iouo, just as if he would stand right in front of you. He listens to you and blesses you for that. A blessing is a present from God. Let your mom and dad explain to you what prayer and blessing means.

There are so many gifts from God to you, that nobody can count them. Your daddy and mommy also gave you many presents. Those are a blessing for you and they bless you with them. Your parents do something good for you. Feel free to say a little "thank you" to them for that at any time!

Why was Jesus made a human by louo, his dear father?
Why was he here on earth, when we humans are so much smaller than angels who can fly anywhere?

Actually, it was not only for the joyous surprise for Jesus to finally have a mom. No, there was a much more important reason why louo God sent Jesus to the earth, which is also called "globe". This globe is just a tiny little point, a sphere in the midst of millions upon millions of huge stars, of which many are bigger than the sun.

The globe is our tiny place where we humans live. It is also

called "Planet Earth".

The reason for Jesus' becoming a human was not meant as a surprise for Jesus, but as a joyous surprise for us humans. In the Bible, "Joyful Surprise" is called "Glad Tidings", "the Happy Good News", "Good News" or "Good Message". A part of the Bible was written in Greek, and the original Greek word used here *euaggelion* is sometimes translated as "Gospel".


This booklet wants to explain to you a little bit these "Joyful News", dear reading child.

The Bible is the book with that news of joy that Iouo God, our dear loving Father, wants to save us from all of today's problems in life, especially from death. The Bible is a thick book which every human should have read, because in it, God gives us a manual for our lives and problems in life and is showing us an escape from death. This hope is the actual surprise for us worried humans.

Because of this hope for salvation, Jesus became human and that is why he came to us on earth. He was to be trained to lead all mankind back to louo and to be able to do that right. It was important for him to get precise knowledge about everything concerning human feelings

and how humans live, in order to feel with them when leading them.

Jesus made many sacrifices and had to suffer a lot in order to be able to help humans. He also did many good deeds in order to show us how earth would be a paradise. He healed many sick people, he even brought dead people back to life. He fed hungry people and performed many other miracles. This was for us to learn that God has the power to heal everyone in the coming paradise. God will turn the world into a paradise, resurrect the dead and bring them into this paradise. God will also make all poverty go away. We will talk about that later on. Jesus suffered for us and took many burdens on his shoulders in order to take the burden of death away from us by his own sufferings.

Mankind in general left God at some point in time many thousand years ago, and most of them stopped loving God louo, although he was the Dear God or the God of Love. He was, is and will be like that forever. Therefore, Jesus has to lead mankind back to God, namely all who accept how God wants to lead them back through Jesus.

All the other ones can't get Iouo God's help. The Dear God's love is not enough to save them.

They remain wicked. Those who remain wicked will once have to sleep forever because they disturb the everlasting peace.

louo, the Dear God who is love, needs peace for all so that they can be in real joy for all times and never are sad, never again! God says he wants to wipe away all tears from the eyes of all for all times.

Wicked is a person who slowly stops to listen to that which is good. They don't obey the parents. They don't listen to relatives. They don't really listen to their teachers when going to school. When being adult, they then stop obeying anyone, who is good and who tries to give the good to them, being concerned about them.

And finally, they stop listening to the Dear God Iouo. Of course they could still eventually somehow repent that. But those who have to sleep eternally don't want to change their attitude. They don't see and realize and understand why they should, and therefore they don't repent anymore. What is meant by "repent"? It is being sad because of one has made a mistake in something God wants to be done differently and then to decide to do better in the future.

One is sad because he loves God so much and has offended Him. All disobedient acts against God are offending God. It is like with your parents or even the same: They are suffering whenever you are not behaving well.

Therefore obeying, listening closely, being ready to listen, good listening, listening to your parents and love are so important! Because you should obey out of love, because you love Daddy and Mom, because you love what is good, because you love God.

So love your Mom and your Dad deeply and tenderly with your whole heart! You have a whole heart when you want to do everything which you should want. Love your Grandpas and your Grandmas, too, and later on love your teacher, when going to school. Honor your Daddy and your Mom! That means: Always do something good for them, at least whenever you are able to! Don't say bad things about them and often say thank you to them! The most important thing, however, is that you obey them gladly and readily; so listen to them with pleasure! Don't resist them!

Then you will never become wicked and louo God will always be glad about you.

He always praises you and he has a special present for you. He, your highest Father, your creator, lets you live forever. He keeps you alive. This one, your Father, is a loving one; he loves you dearly with his whole heart.

Therefore, always do your very best and practice to listen, to be ready to listen and to obey, in other words to love.

Practice it until you never can lose of it! Do it like your

Mom and your Daddy are doing it, they are your example.

Jesus and God Iouo, however, are your example in all things. Iouo God, your Father, can do many things, yes, even nearly everything. Jesus can't do as much as Iouo. He said: "My Father is greater than I am." But God can't do one certain thing: He can't turn any creature, thus no single human, to be good or bad.

This, everyone has to decide for himself and for him alone. Also you, dear reading child, you decide yourself what you want: good or bad; doing what is allowed or what is forbidden; what is correct or what is wrong; what is right or what is wicked; if you want to obey or disobey; if you want to listen to Mom and Dad or if you don't listen. This is called: Your free will. Iouo God gave all creatures a free will as a present!


Jesus, too, is a present to us from God. He will be our leader who leads us back to Him. He is the only human who deserves the title "Leader" (German: "Führer"). Jesus therefore taught many important things to help us find back to God. He even taught us what we should especially pray for. Of course you can, nevertheless, tell God Iouo all your thoughts and wishes. He told us, too, that we should pray: "May your Kingdom come!" When we pray often for that, the Paradise – which is the Kingdom of God – might just come a little bit earlier, a little bit quicker, a little bit sooner, maybe very soon. Then things would turn good on earth earlier.

louo actually listens to us very gladly, whenever we pray to him out of love, wholeheartedly, in all sincerity. You can say: "God listens to my prayer." when God does what you humbly ask for in prayer. Even a little innocent child can move God to listen to him or her and to do what he or she is asking of Him. See how loving the Dear God is! A prayer of an innocent one has much power. And if he isn't innocent because of a mistake, he should pray even more for louo's help to repent and to improve his behavior.

But what exactly is the "Kingdom of God"? It is the time, when Jesus will build up the Paradise on earth until all humans are good again. It will last for one Thousand years. "Paradise" means the first large garden which louo created for the first humans to live in. They should have stretched this Paradise over the whole earth by educating children who then would have helped to enlarge the Paradise. But the first humans didn't want that. They didn't obey God. They became wicked. But Jesus came. So soon from now the earth will become a paradise nevertheless. A Paradise is a garden of security with many flowers and beautiful plants where no one is sick. It is a place of happiness and of delight, where all animals are peaceful and tame and can be petted, where there is only peace and joy and love, total prosperity.

We should also pray: "Our Father in heaven: Make Your name be sanctified!" The name "louo" which is the name of God stands for love. A pupil of Jesus wrote in the Bible: "God is love". Those having learned from Jesus are called "disciples of Jesus". A disciple is a person who is learning or a pupil. The first disciples of Jesus were also called "apostles" which means a person sent out. This comes from the word "send".

The apostles, the ones sent out by Jesus, should announce the Good News of the surprise of louo everywhere, namely that he saves us from wickedness. They should make that known. For that purpose, Jesus sent them out. They should sanctify the name of God namely "louo", what means that they should tell this name to everybody, to broadcast it, to praise it with loud voice. The sanctification also means not to use God's name for a bad purpose or to hide it fully or to avoid it, to forget it or let it be forgotten or to be even ashamed when it is necessary to mention it. To sanctify it therefore means to like to speak about it joyfully and to use it in every day's talking without being ashamed!

To sanctify a name also means not to pronounce it wrong or to change it or to replace it with other words.

The apostles made the name "louo" known everywhere. The devil was very angry about that. He is the enemy of God and is the source of all wickedness. Already since the beginning of this sinful world, he tried to wipe out the correct holy name of God, and he influenced many wicked humans to do that. The devil soon will be brought to an eternal sleep.

Me, I also make the name "louo" known as I do with this booklet. Why? Because I learned that humans find to God much earlier and much faster whenever they learn and use God's name "louo", preferably in daily conversation but in any case in one's prayer.

The disciples or the apostles used the name louo in the new part of the Bible as it was common from old times onward also in the old part of the Bible. Thus it was written everywhere in the Bible. Wicked men wiped out the name louo both from the old part and especially from the new part. The old part is also called: "Old Testament", the new part is also called "New Testament".

It lasted even some thousands of years till some humans brought back God's name into the Old Testament and into the New Testament again.

But the name of God existed for a long time in an unholy form, which is wrong, because the correct Name Iouo was totally forgotten.

Wrong forms were "Yahweh" or also "Yehowah", "Jehovah", "Jehova", "Geova" and the like, for instance also "Yehwah", "Yehwih", "Ieue" and there are still other wrong forms. The most wicked thing was whenever instead of the name of God simply "the Lord", "Lord", "der Herr", "HErr", sometimes also "the Eternal One" was written.

How would your Daddy react, when nobody would continue to use his name, when everyone just would address him with "Mister", "you Mister", "you Lord"? Would he like that?

These are the languages of the Bible translations there: German, English, French, Spanish, Portuguese, Chinese, Japanese, Persian, Arabic, Turkish, Osmanic and Adamic; the New Testament in Greek. Parts of the Bible are also available in Russian and Hindi. Adamic was the language of the first human. Nearly the whole Old Testament was written in that language.

For the part of mankind wishing to become good, namely all humans that want to be guided by Jesus, there is still much work to be done until the whole sanctuary of God on earth is restored. A teacher of old times called Daniel once prophesied a thought given to him by an angel: the restoration of all these holy things will still take hundreds of years after paradise will have started on earth. These holy things are first the name "louo" in all Bibles in around 10.000 languages. Then the original text of the Bible in Adamic, Aramaic and Greek must be restored in many places. And God even wants to add new books to the Bible.

Already today, nobody should make fun of the day of humble beginnings.


This is also what the Bible shows. Already today some steps are made for the purpose of sanctification, though only small steps. Many make fun of that and this is wicked. Ridiculing the things of God is always wicked.

We should also pray for what Jesus showed: "Make your will be done!", as we can read in the model for correct praying called "The Lord's prayer". Why should we pray: "Make your will be done!"? God only wants what is good, only good things, and his will is always only good, without exception. Therefore we can and should do what is God's will. Then we become good humans. There will be a time when the will of God will be done everywhere on earth without exception. This should be our wish as well, and therefore we should pray for that.

If we do God's will, we will never have to sleep forever.

God's commandments are not difficult. It is really easy to obey God, if we don't have too many wishes that seek wrong things. The more we want wrong things, the more difficult it gets for us to obey louo. Then it will slowly become as difficult as getting through a jungle or a thicket.

"Wanting very much" is also called "greed". Greed will totally disappear someday in the future. The Bible shows: The wicked world will not exist anymore and also greed will disappear someday in the future. But the one doing God's will will stay on forever, meaning for all times he will not have to sleep forever.

Greed means wanting things too fast and very badly. You are allowed to want things, yes, you even should want things. That is the reason God gave us free will. When you want good things, it is called "desire", "demand", "need" or "necessity". But sadly, some use the word "greed" in a good sense. This is actually wrong. "Greed" is an extreme desire for something wrong, a wicked craving. We are not allowed to be greedy: this is wicked.

Greed, also called "covetousness" will totally vanish in the future, because Jesus will lead us to God. Without Jesus, nobody can find to God.

There are many forms of greed: eating too quickly,

or always wanting something right away, wanting something which is forbidden, or wanting very much or very expensive things no matter the circumstances or absolutely wanting what you like in any case.

We are not perfect and we have faults! Therefore louo doesn't expect us that we do everything perfectly already today. We do not need to always do everything totally right. God only wants us to feel sad about our mistakes and to do our best in order to avoid mistakes and do better next time.

The reason for being sad is that we like God and do not want to make him sad. We are allowed to show this affection, this love at all times. Nobody ridicules that. Your parents, Daddy and Mom always show their love to you. First try to do things in a way that others feel you like them. Doing everything right is not as important as showing your love. Then Daddy and Mom might caress your head and Mom might praise you saying: "Well done!" Daddy might be glad and say: "Good going. Keep it up!" They might even say that if actually not everything was alright. But also that can often be a good thing.



If anybody is laughing at you, simply laugh along and think to yourself: "How sad that he doesn't know God!"

In this booklet there are also many mistakes and many things could have or ought to have been written in a better way. But I hope and pray that you, dear reading child, can at least see that I really love you with all of my heart and that this is the reason for me writing it.

Jesus loves you even more than I do, and he has returned to heaven a long time ago when his task on earth was fulfilled after living on it for almost 35 years. This return of Jesus to his heavenly Father is called: "Ascension of Christ". His apostles where watching when he disappeared in a cloud lifting him up back to the heaven. Soon, Jesus will start to bring about the Paradise on earth. He does that from where he is in heaven. Then, along with his father louo, he will lead all obedient humans with good will for real love to eternal joy.

My grandfather Wilhelm (English: William), my grandpa, whose grave is in Münster (Germany) once said: "In moderation (namely the right measure), everything is medicine." Therefore, also my father said the same thing to me and taught me it. Jesus wants the same: "Be not overly wicked nor overly righteous. Why should you bring devastation over you?" Everybody is still a little disobedient, and some want to be perfect already today. Both things do not help you. You should continue to love, even when making mistakes. And do not start to think: "I don't care if my actions are OK, my mistakes don't bother me at all!" This was the advice of my grandfather and it actually comes from Jesus. This is my advice to you, too, my dear reading child. It is the counsel of God in the Bible. namely in Ecclesiastes. Everything in the Bible is counsel from Jesus who is called "Christ" and is also called "the word of God".

louo and Jesus Christ want to help you to find to Paradise and therefore give us many similar pieces of advice. A whole lot of them can be found in the Bible, which they commanded to be written for that purpose.

The purpose and the message of the Bible - which is <u>also</u> called "God's Word" - is to teach us to love each other and to love all fellow creatures, humans and animals. We should also learn to be respectful towards one another and to hold everyone in high regard, even if someone has made a mistake. We love him nevertheless and forgive him readily, as louo forgives us gladly and quickly. Forgiving is also forgetting. Is such a God not very loving? Should we not love him very much? Jesus said: "Love God more than anything else and love one another as you love yourself!"

All of that you can start learning to do by loving Daddy and Mom. By always listening to them and behaving well. Do also love your relatives: your great-grandfathers and great-grandmothers, your grandfathers and grandmothers, your great-uncles and great-aunts, your uncles and aunts. Also love your siblings, your brothers and sisters, and also your cousins. Love your friends, playmates when going into Kindergarten, schoolmates when going to school. Love your cat, your dog, your bunny, your guinea-pig, your hamster, or what other pet you might have.

Also love the friends and colleagues of your parents. They are all God's beloved children. And God even suffers when a little sparrow is in trouble.


